In order to make all these things happen, we need you!

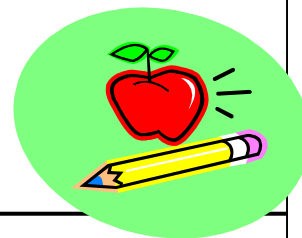
How to help...

Tips For A Smooth Drop-Off And Pick-Up
